questions about energy monitoring and efficiency, precision production, employee assistance systems and much more.

"The real-world laboratory is a driver of innovation and offers us the unique opportunity to test new technologies directly in a practical environment. Especially in times of rapid change, it is essential for us as a company to test new solutions early and cost-effectively before we integrate them into production," emphasises **Elisabeth Jahns, Director Operations, eAx Solutions.** The company is already actively involved in the design of the real-world laboratory.

Despite the difficult situation, the transformation also offers opportunities. Through networks such as Re-TraNetz-BB, companies can strengthen their competitiveness and explore new paths. The Berlin-Brandenburg metropolitan region in particular is characterised by a strong start-up mentality and a large number of digitalisation companies and scientific institutions.
